Development of the Green Economy in Tajikistan

The Dushanbe Economic Meeting is an established platform for dialogue between Tajikistan's private and public sectors and has been conducted since 2014. Each year, a specific topic is chosen for discussion.

In 2022, the theme of the Economic Meeting is "Development of the Green Economy in Tajikistan". During the conference, it is planned to have reports of ministries and state agencies of Tajikistan on strategic documents and economic policy aimed at the development of a green economy, to learn the experience of implementation of green economy principles by the private sector, and to discuss the regional and international experience. An important part of the Dushanbe Economic Meeting is discussions between government agencies, the private sector, business associations and academia representatives. As a result of the discussions, it is planned to define a common vision of the state of the green economy in the medium term and to make recommendations to translate this vision into reality.
